Recent reports(\*) reveal that 95% of leaders in People and Culture roles find their function to be overly burdensome and stressful.

Only 29% feel that their work is valued. Additionally, 76% of their key stakeholders state that the current focus of the area remains administrative and process-oriented, while organizations need them to evolve towards a more strategic and consultative role.

This complexity invites us to inhabit ambiguity and embrace the constant paradoxes that emerge, such as: "91% of People and Culture leaders express enthusiasm for their vocation and the potential of the function, yet 81% report experiencing burnout and even 62% are considering leaving the role."

The changes that have impacted businesses and cultures over recent years have been drastic and show no signs of slowing down.
